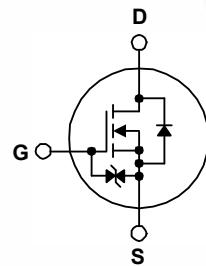
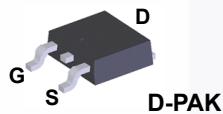

Figure 1. On-Region Characteristics

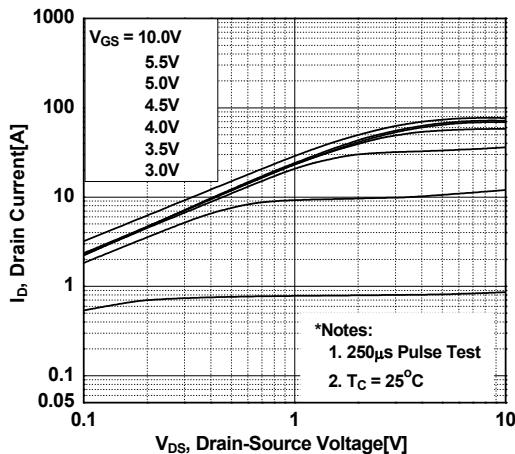


Figure 2. Transfer Characteristics

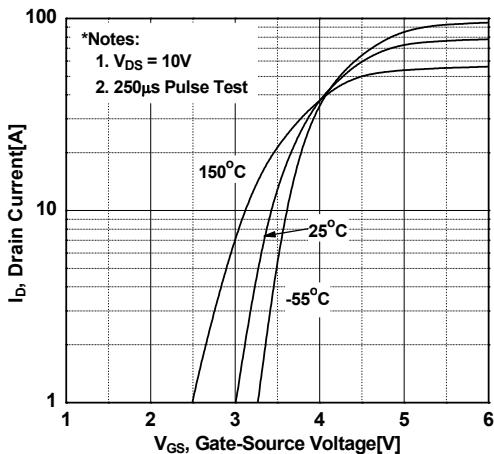


Figure 3. On-Resistance Variation vs. Drain Current and Gate Voltage

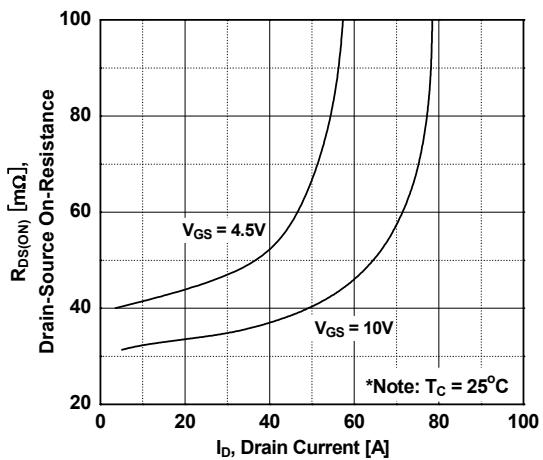


Figure 4. Body Diode Forward Voltage Variation vs. Source Current and Temperature

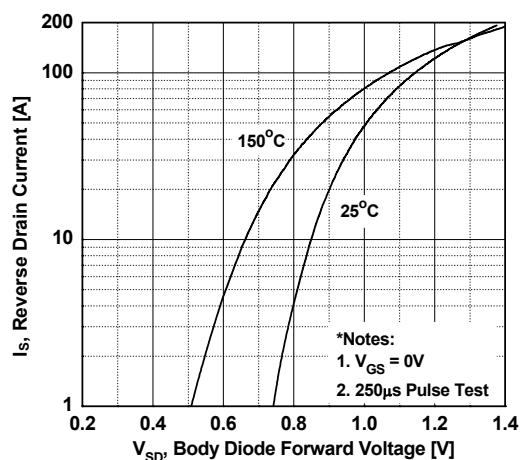


Figure 5. Capacitance Characteristics

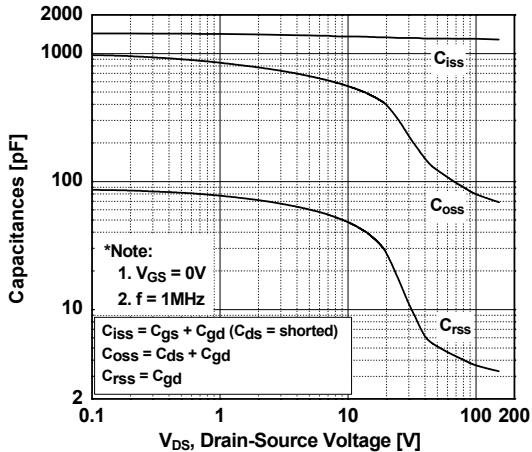
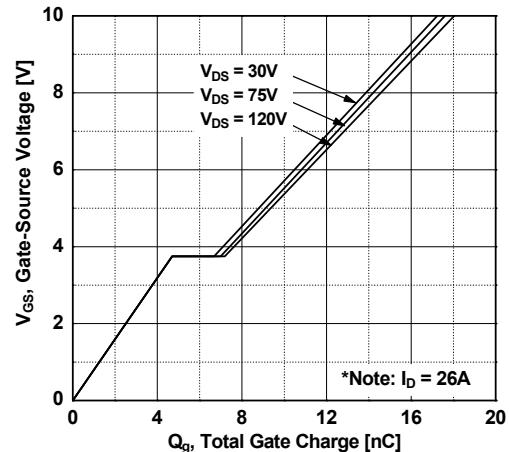


Figure 6. Gate Charge Characteristics

Figure 7. Breakdown Voltage Variation vs. Temperature

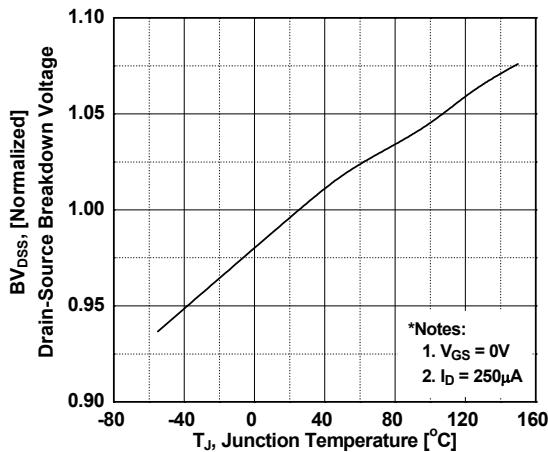


Figure 8. On-Resistance Variation vs. Temperature

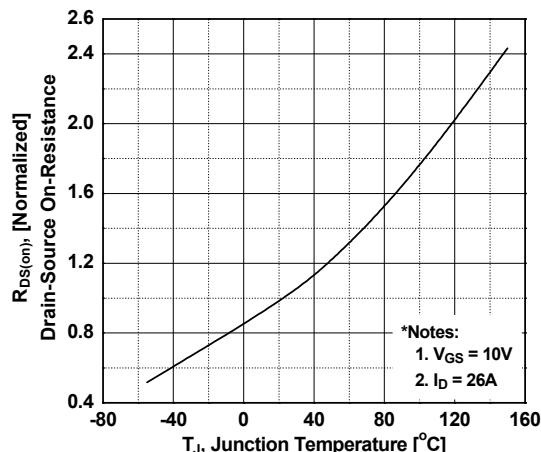


Figure 9. Maximum Safe Operating Area

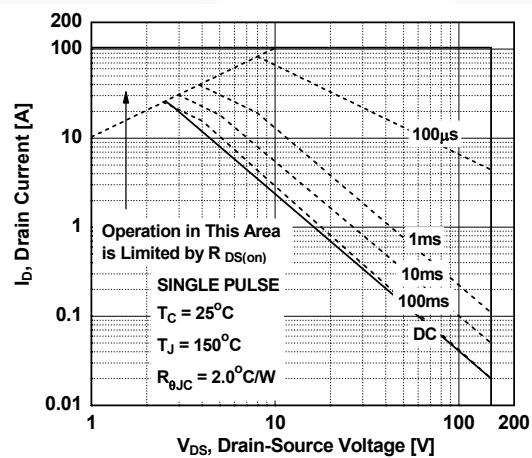


Figure 10. Maximum Drain Current vs. Case Temperature

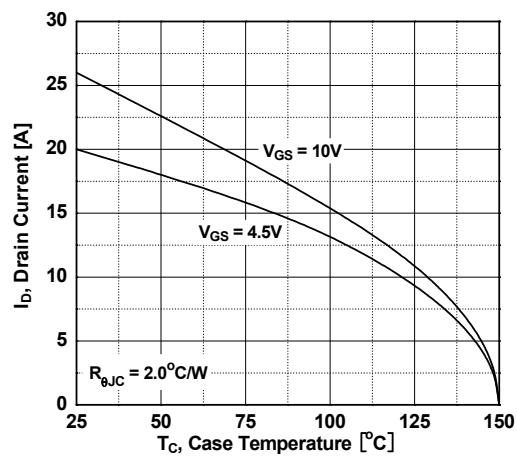


Figure 11. Eoss vs. Drain to Source Voltage

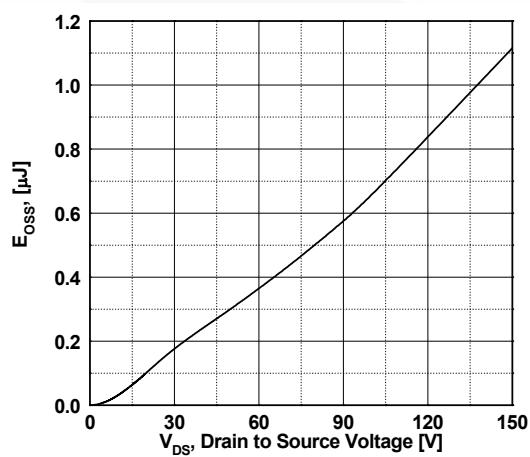
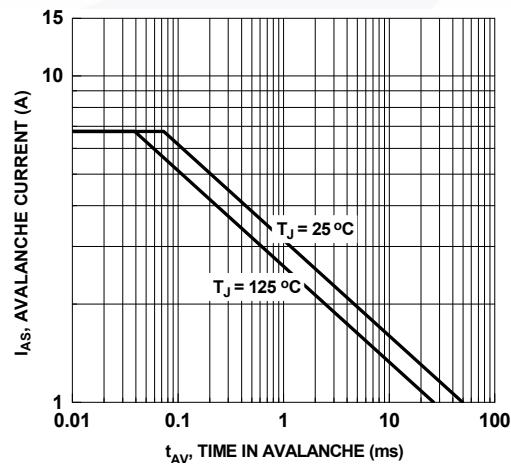
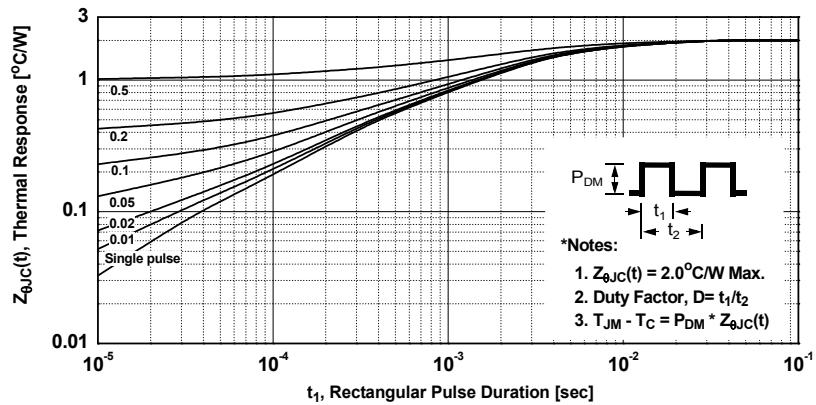


Figure 12. Unclamped Inductive Switching Capability

Figure 13. Transient Thermal Response Curve



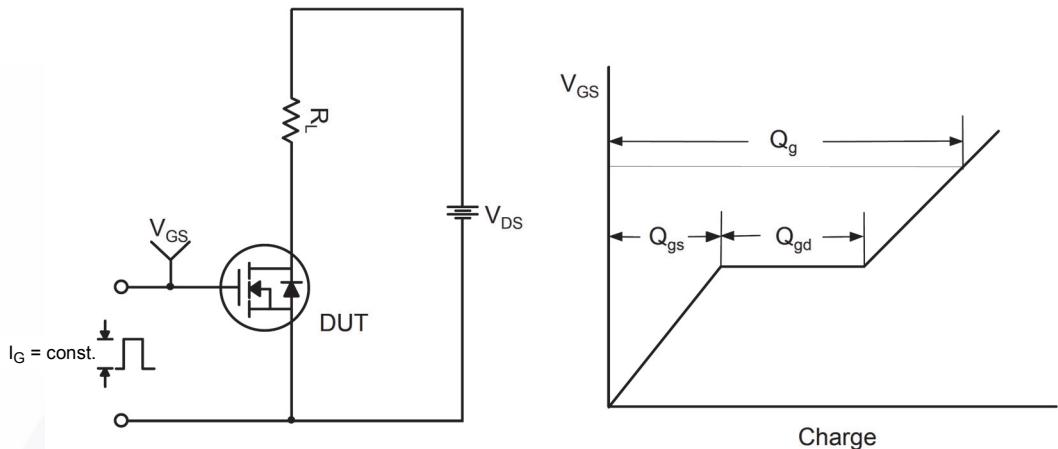


Figure 14. Gate Charge Test Circuit & Waveform

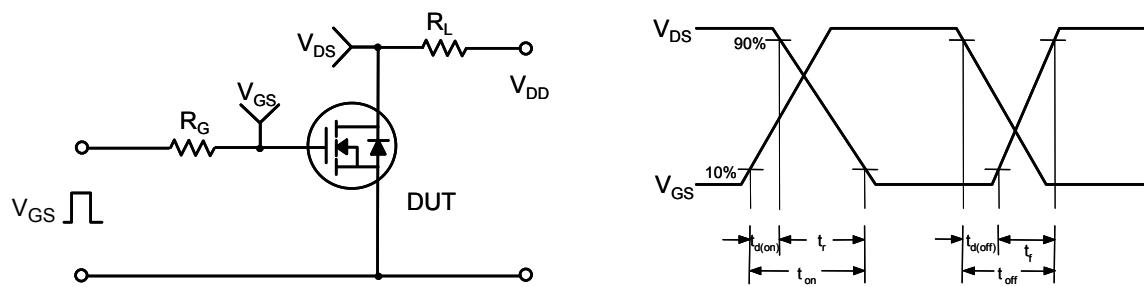


Figure 15. Resistive Switching Test Circuit & Waveforms

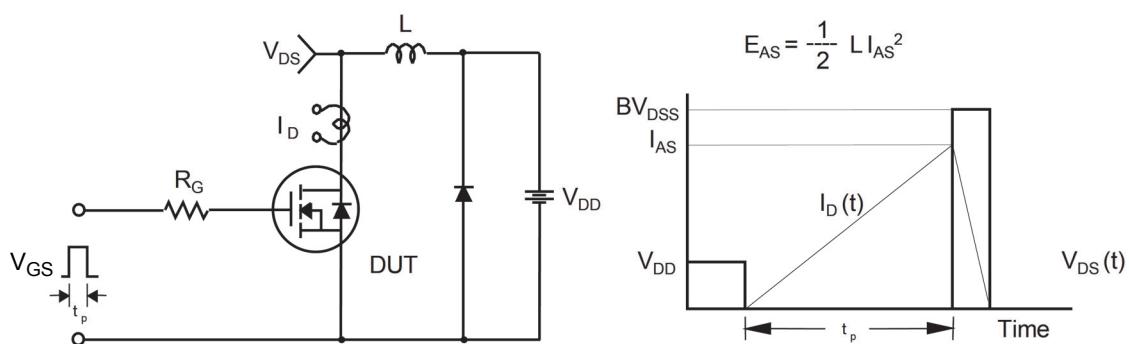


Figure 16. Unclamped Inductive Switching Test Circuit & Waveforms

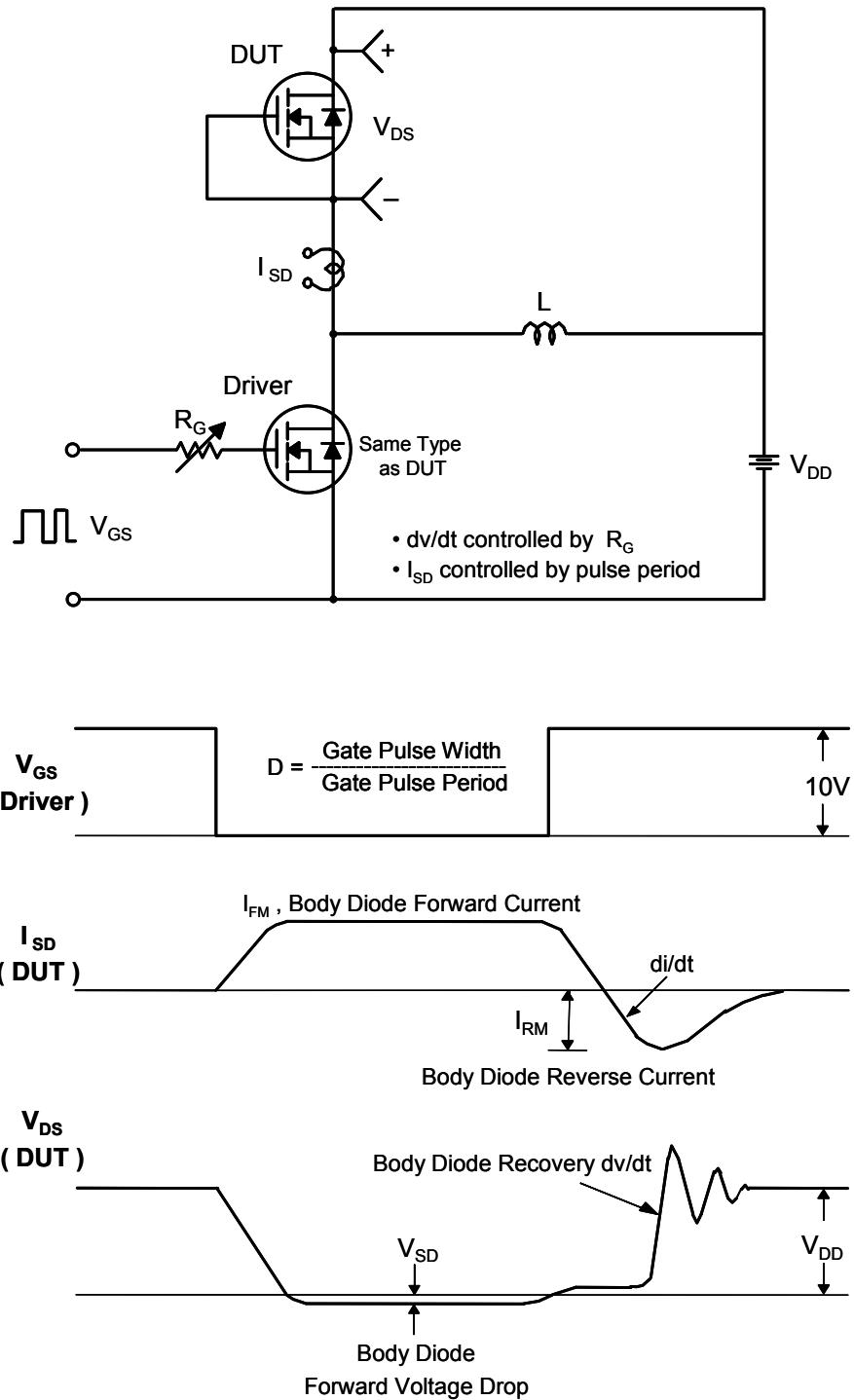


Figure 17. Peak Diode Recovery dv/dt Test Circuit & Waveforms

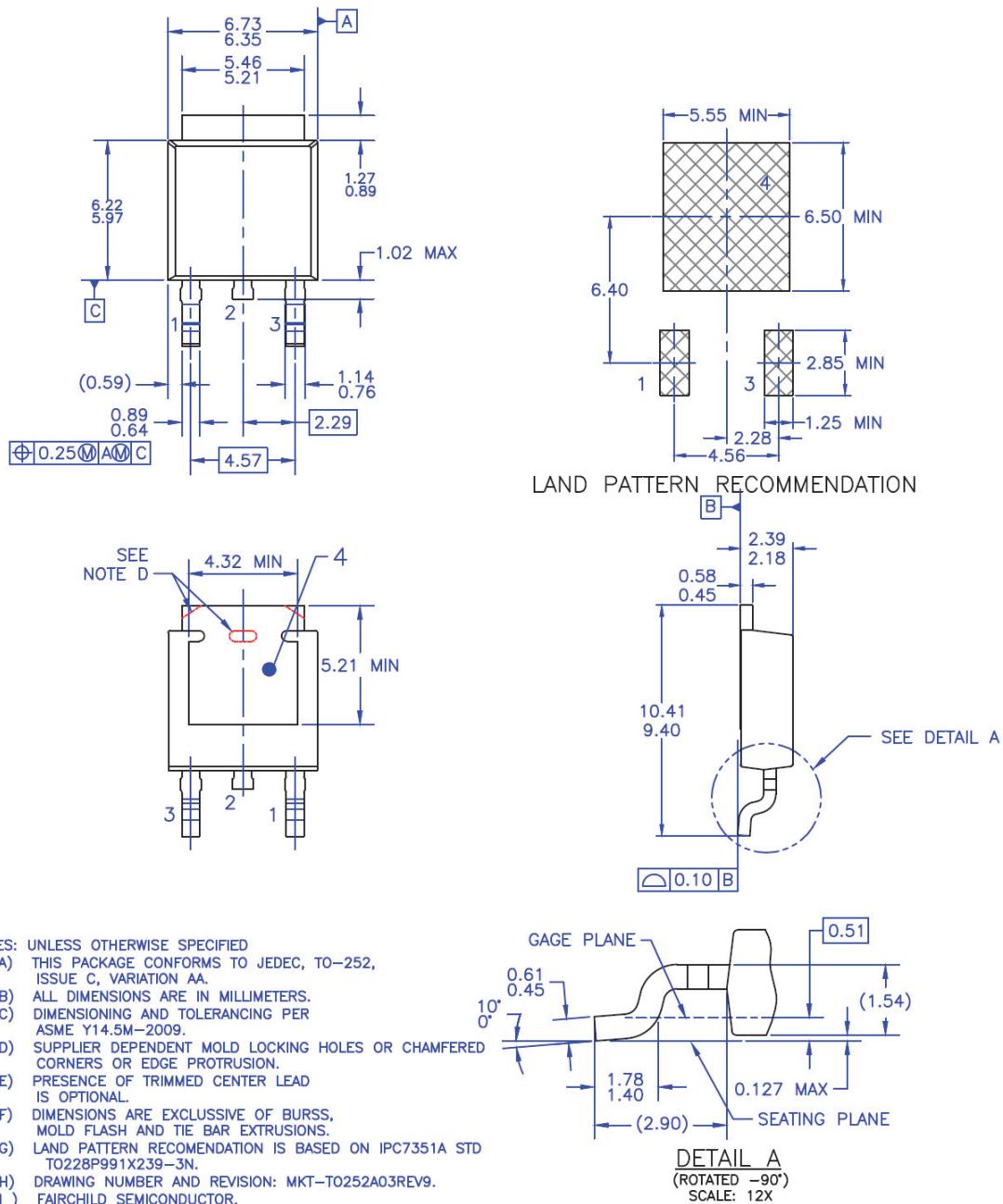


Figure 18. TO252 (D-PAK), Molded, 3-Lead, Option AA&AB
