


- R_{0JA} is the sum of the junction-to-case and case-to-ambient thermal resistance where the case thermal reference is defined as the solder mounting surface of the drain pins. R_{0JC} is guaranteed by design while R_{0CA} is determined by the user's board design.

- Pulse Test: Pulse Width < 300μs, Duty Cycle < 2.0%

- Maximum current is calculated as:
$$I_D = \sqrt{\frac{P_D}{R_{DS(on)}}}$$

where P_D is maximum power dissipation at $T_C = 25^\circ\text{C}$ and $R_{DS(\text{on})}$ is at $T_{J(\text{max})}$ and $V_{GS} = 10\text{V}$. Package current limitation is 21A




Figure 1. On-Region Characteristics.




Figure 2. On-Resistance Variation with Drain Current and Gate Voltage.




Figure 3. On-Resistance Variation with Temperature.




Figure 4. On-Resistance Variation with Gate-to-Source Voltage.




Figure 5. Transfer Characteristics.




Figure 6. Body Diode Forward Voltage Variation with Source Current and Temperature.




Figure 7. Gate Charge Characteristics.




Figure 8. Capacitance Characteristics.




Figure 9. Maximum Safe Operating Area.




Figure 10. Single Pulse Maximum Power Dissipation.









Figure 11. Transient Thermal Response Curve.
