### 1.1 General description

Logic level N-channel enhancement mode Field-Effect Transistor (FET) in a plastic package using TrenchMOS technology. This product has been designed and qualified to the appropriate AEC standard for use in automotive critical applications.

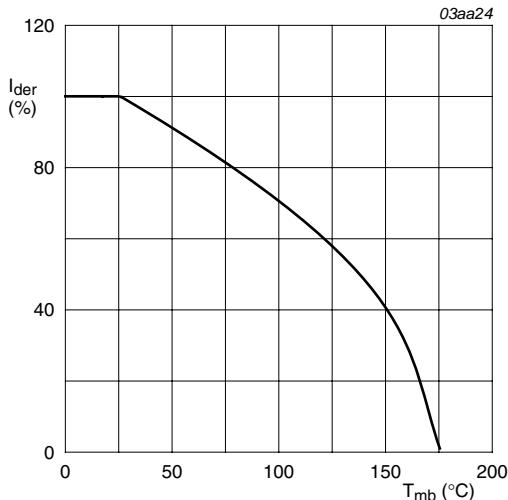

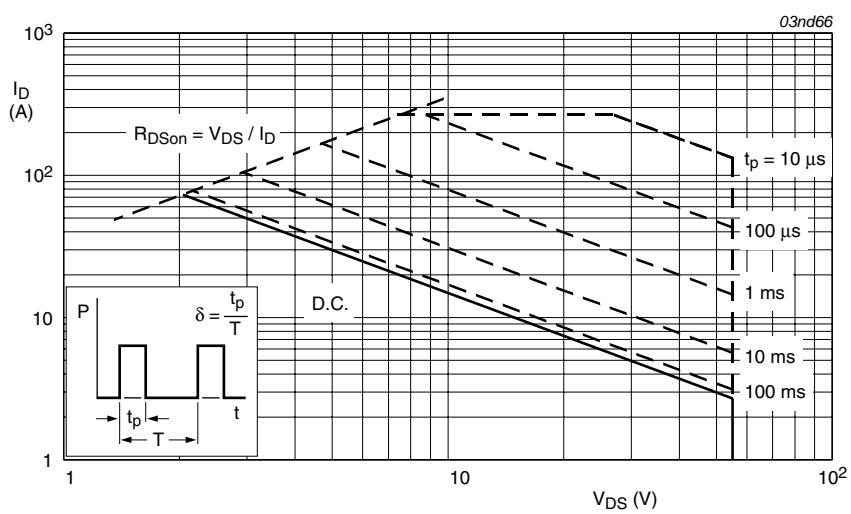

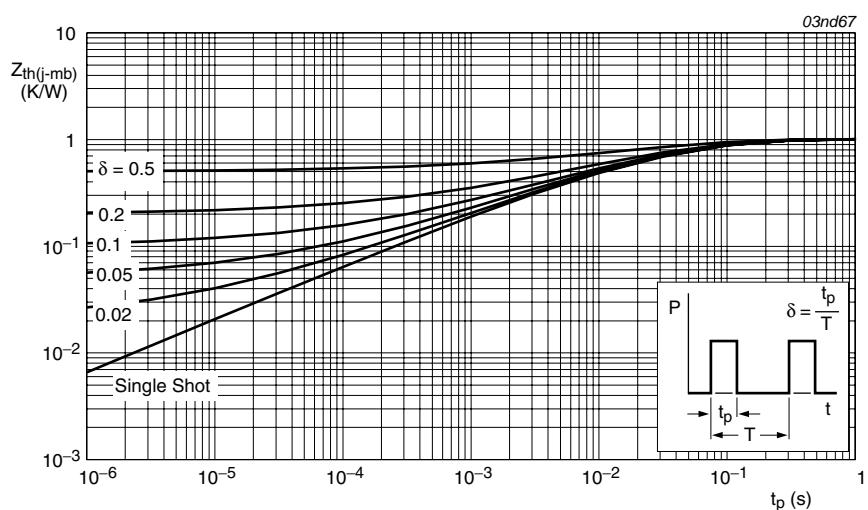
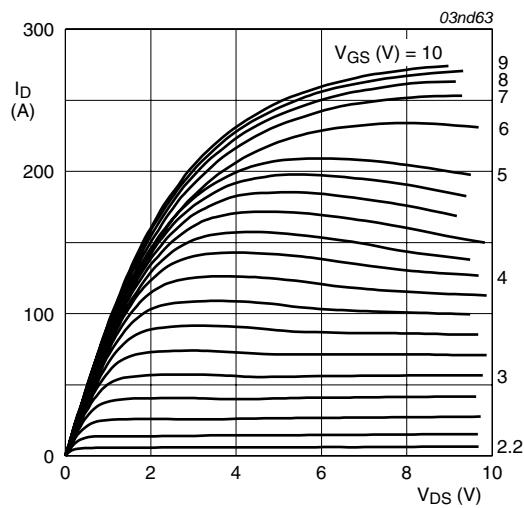


Fig 4. Transient thermal impedance from junction to mounting base as a function of pulse duration

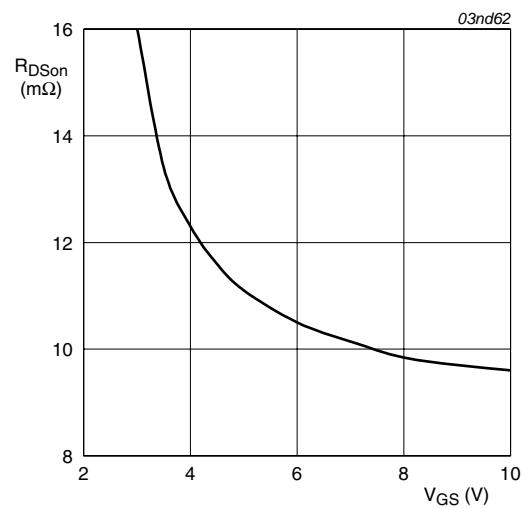

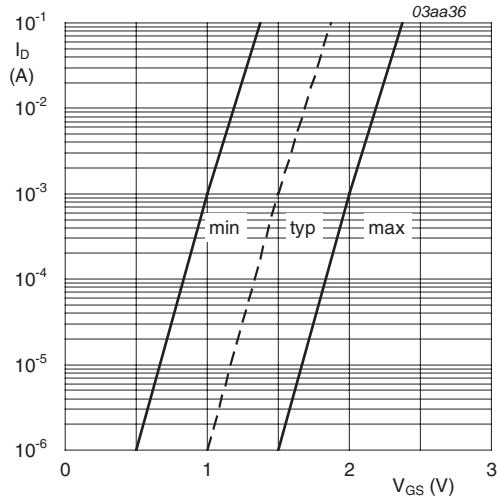

**Fig 5. Output characteristics: drain current as a function of drain-source voltage; typical values**



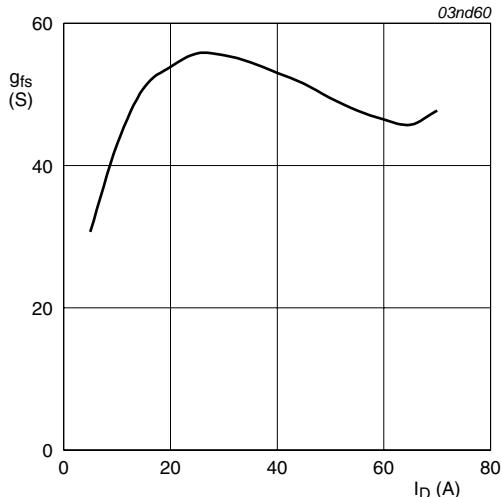

**Fig 6. Drain-source on-state resistance as a function of gate-source voltage; typical values**



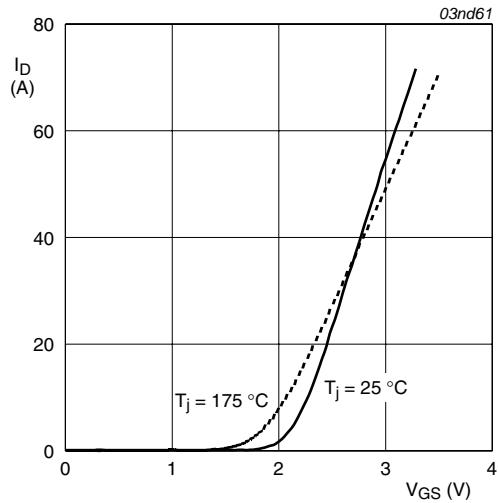

**Fig 7. Sub-threshold drain current as a function of gate-source voltage**

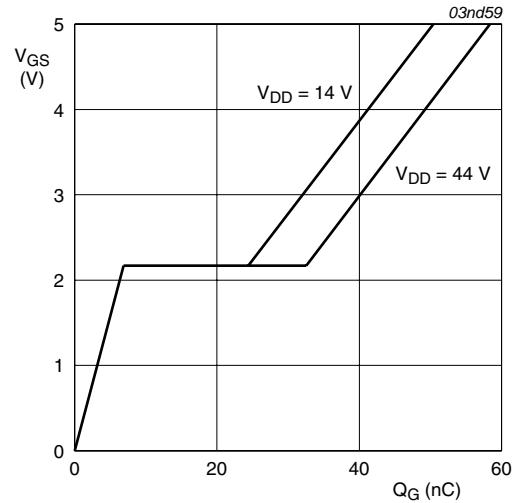

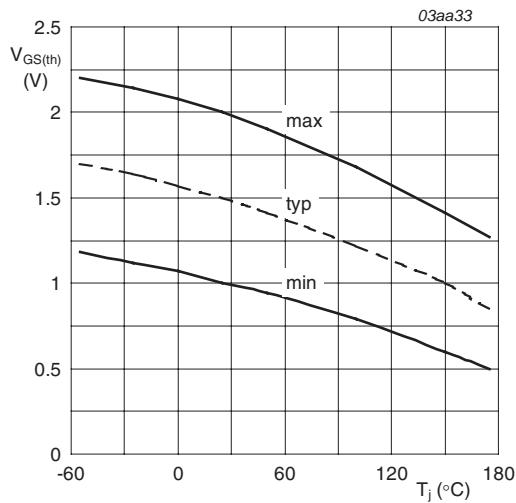
**Fig 8. Forward transconductance as a function of drain current; typical values**



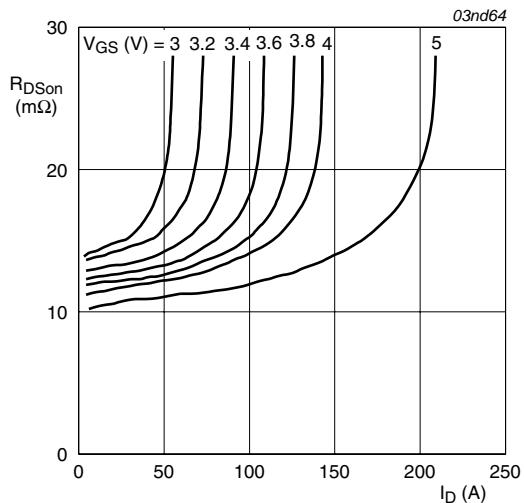
**Fig 9. Transfer characteristics: drain current as a function of gate-source voltage; typical values**



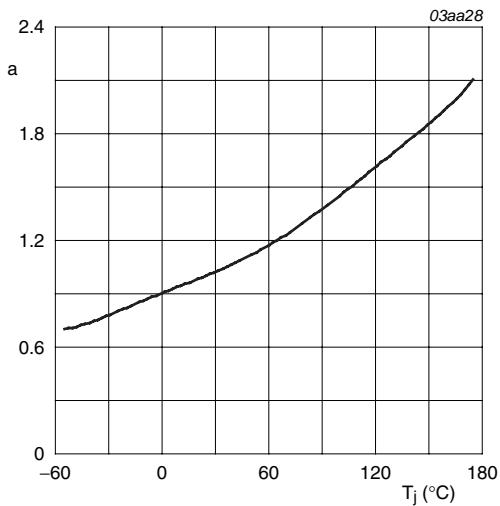
**Fig 10. Gate-source voltage as a function of gate charge; typical values**



**Fig 11. Gate-source threshold voltage as a function of junction temperature**

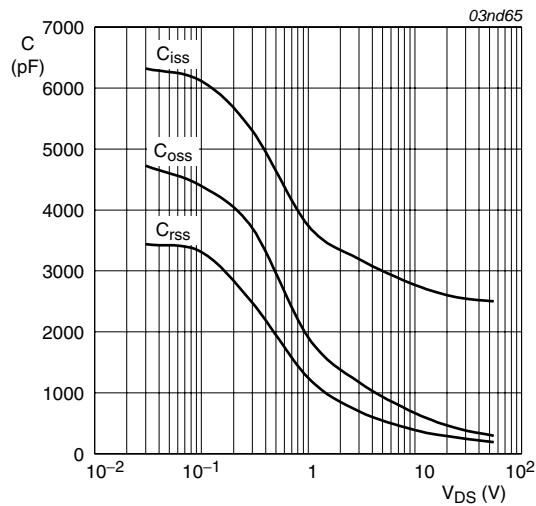


**Fig 12. Drain-source on-state resistance as a function of drain current; typical values**



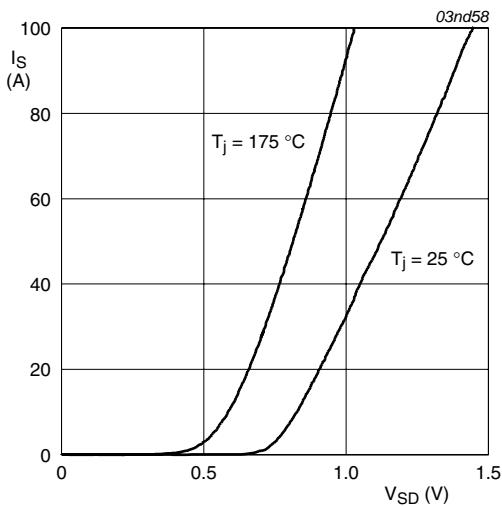

**Fig 14. Input, output and reverse transfer capacitances as a function of drain-source voltage; typical values**



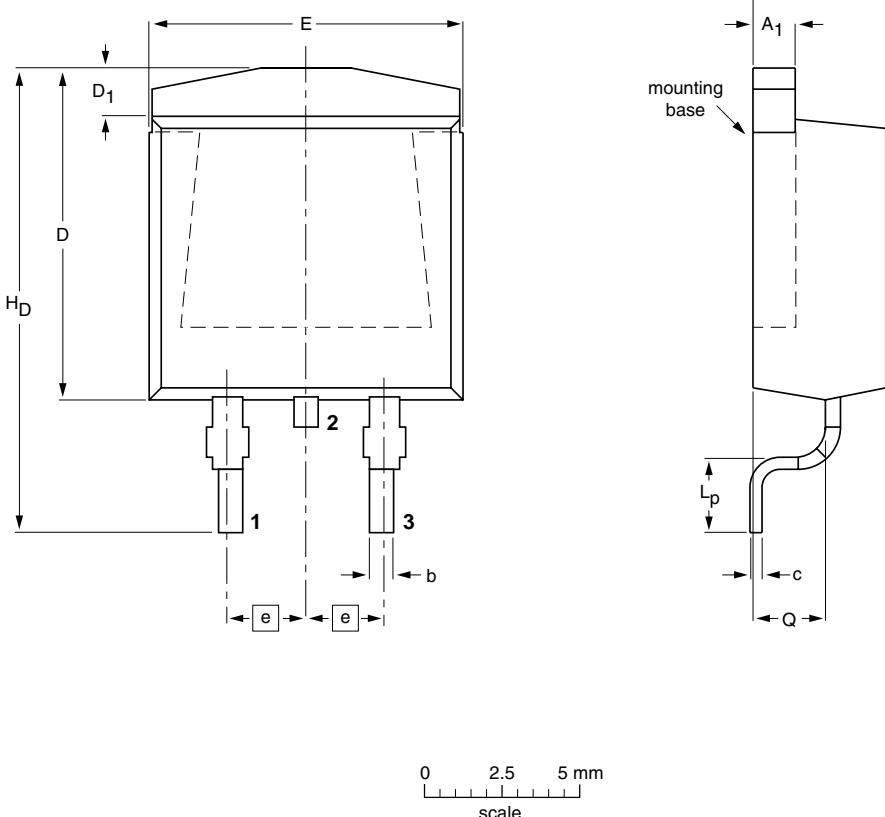
